2009 Conditions of Play

The format for this event is a multi-day pro-am similar to the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am. Female professionals will be paired with sponsors to compete in a Pro-Am competition while simultaneously participating in the Open Championship. Female amateurs with less than a 6.0 Handicap Index are also invited to participate in the Open Championship; however, they may not compete in the Pro-am.

Entries

This event is open to female professionals and amateurs with a USGA Handicap Index of 6.0 or lower.

Entries close at 5:00 pm MDT on Wednesday, May 6.

Colorado PGA Women & Golf Day

After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 20 teams plus ties and the lowest 40 individual scorers plus any ties.

Friday, May 29 3rd round

Exemptions —players in the following categories shall be exempt into the Championship provided that a completed entry is received prior to the deadline, and she is otherwise eligible. *A complete list of exempt players is listed on the reverse side of this page.*

1. All former Colorado Women's Open Champions
2. **SPECIAL FOR 2009 ONLY!** All players (amateurs and professionals) that made the cut in the 2008 Colorado Women's Open Championship
3. Colorado Section of the PGA has 5 exemptions to use at their discretion.
4. Colorado Women's Golf Association has 15 exemptions to issue at their discretion to top Colorado female amateurs
5. If eligible, the championship host site professional
6. One returning player from the following local Division I University's women's golf teams: University of Colorado, Colorado State University, University of Denver, University of Northern Colorado and the University of Wyoming. The Head Coach of each program will determine at his/her discretion the player to receive the invitation.
7. Sponsor Selection: up to 5 exemptions are issued from the top sponsors.
8. Any player that has made the Colorado Women's Open Championship cut at least thrice out of the past five years (2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008)

Playoff

For the Open Championship - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #18 and continuing on #18 until the Champion is determined.

For Open Championship Low Amateur - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #10 and continuing on #10 until the winner is determined.

For the Pro-Am - no playoff; co-champions will be awarded.

Prizes

For the Open Championship - **\$55,000** purse (including Amateur prize payout of approximately \$5000)

For the Pro-Am - **\$18,000** purse (including Amateur prize payout of approximately \$4000)

The Open Champion Receives

- \$11,000 and trophy
- An exemption into all future Colorado Women's Open Championships.

The Low Amateur Receives

- \$750 gift certificate
- Trophy

The Low Pro-Am Team Receives

- Professional: \$3200
- Amateur: \$750 gift certificate
- Trophy for each player
