Why Volunteer?

What does it take?

Desire. Our mentors have a desire to spend time with young people.

Commitment. The First Tee of Green Valley Ranch asks that volunteers make a commitment to be available on a consistent basis. Volunteering for an extended period gives you an opportunity to witness, firsthand, increased levels of confidence, transformations of golf swings, and participants learning valuable life skills.

Criminal Background Check. In an effort to provide a safe environment for the youth in our program, The First Tee of Green Valley Ranch requires all of its volunteers to undergo a criminal background investigation.

Training. Volunteers are required to attend a training session each year. The training will go over the basics of our program enabling you, to answer general questions from parents. The sessions will also provide an overview of the code of conduct the students in the program are expected to follow

When can I Volunteer? Programming runs from April to October. Instructional classes are offered throughout the week and a Friday Play Day is held each week. **Please note: we do not offer programming during the weeks that we host the COBank Colorado Open Championships:**
